

FULL-DAY TOUR AT NINH BINH BEAR SANCTUARY

For students age 16 and above

Overview:

Tour type: Private

Travel style: Educational, Ecotourism **Transfer distance:** approx. 120km/ way

Duration: ~7 hours (9:00 – 16.15) **Meals**: Lunch (vegetarian)

Tour starts & ends in Hanoi

Highlights:

- Opportunity to explore valuable knowledge about animal welfare and apply it to real-life situations.
- Hands-on experience in bear conservation and care.
- Foster proactive learning and teamwork skills.
- Promote active engagement in raising awareness about wildlife and nature conservation.

Detail itinerary:

In the early morning, our guide and driver will pick you up from your hotel in Hanoi and transfer you to Ninh Binh, approximately a 2.5-hour drive away. Upon reaching the bear sanctuary, you will receive a warm welcome and an introduction to the sanctuary itself. During your visit, you'll have the opportunity to learn about the mission, vision, and purpose of this sanctuary and gain insights into the ongoing bear-related issues in Vietnam.

Next, you will take part in a workshop titled "Understanding Animal Welfare," where you'll have the chance to engage in a communication project focused on animal welfare. Following the workshop, you'll explore the educational exhibition via the elevated walkway at the Bear Sanctuary Ninh Binh. During this time, you'll also participate in group discussions to brainstorm communication ideas.

Lunch (vegetarian) will be served at 11:30 AM at the restaurant inside the sanctuary.

In the afternoon, you will engage in hands-on activities within the internal areas where staff members are dedicated to caring for the bears and ensuring their welfare. Additionally, you will collaborate to brainstorm and implement a Communication Project centered around the theme "Gen Z for Animal Welfare."
