

DAY TRIPS IN LAOS

TOURS ESCAPE FROM LUANG PRABANG

OVERVIEW

Situated in northern Laos at the confluence of the Nam Khan and Mekong Rivers, the ancient town of Luang Prabang was declared as UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1995. The small city is an outstanding example of the fusion between traditional architecture and Lao urban structures with those built by the European colonial authorities.

Luang Prabang was the ancient royal capital of the Lan Xang Kingdom until 1545 when Vientiane was chosen the capital. The myriad temples, saffron-robed monks, sacred caves and colonial buildings, hill tribes, the well-recognized hand-woven silk and cotton textiles with local patterns which deeply reflect century-old tradition, cozy atmosphere and laid-back pace of life, all become the undeniable trademarks of this ancient town. Cascading waterfalls and the mighty Mekong River with plenty of opportunities to unwind and sail your way through the town are some of other highlights the town has on offer. Luang Prabang is simply a must for any first-time visitors to the country.

Overview:

The northern Laos is home to many ethnic minorities such as Hmong, Khmu. This full day excursion is an ideal getaway from the ancient town of Luang Prabang to numerous villages where these hill tribes inhabit; discover their lifestyles and lush mountain views.

Itinerary:

9:00 AM. Your guide picks you up at your hotel to drive up hill toward North-East of air-port via Hath Hient Village. You stop here to experience how villagers make iron knife. We continue to Ban Pickngai (Yuan ethnic minority). Passing the paddy rice field, you will arrive at Ban None Tan (Khmu & Low Land ethnic minority) and to Ban Kok Wan (Khmu & Low Land). Your guide will prepare and cook a picnic lunch with local food while you're enjoying the beautiful landscape of Hmong ethnic minority village. After lunch, you can take a swimming in Nam Pa River, one of the most scenic rivers if wanted. You are driven along the Nam Pa River bank to Ban Bo Hae, Ban Tha Oui and Ban Kok Muang to visit the Hmong villages. Tour ends at your hotel in late afternoon
