

# **TOURS ESCAPE FROM QUY NHON**

Quy Nhon is the coastal city in Binh Dinh province in central Vietnam. For local people, it is a kind of place to spend couples of day watching the ocean and walking promenade. For foreigners, it becomes less popular. But Quy Nhon deserves to be visited more even though it is not considered as a tourist destination. The medium-size city is blessed with a terrific shoreline of sandy beaches, appeal and tidy. And the countryside that surrounds it is also breathtaking.

Quy Nhon was established as the capital city in the late  $19^{th}$  century but its history dates back to the  $11^{th}$  century in the time of Champa Kingdom. In the  $15^{th}$  century, it also served as the ruling center of Le Thanh Tong – one of the greatest emperors of Vietnamese history. During the Vietnam War, it was a site for intense battle and an important US military and naval base.

Today, the city is a developing port. Fishing and agriculture are the main industries here, making it a food spot to sample some fresh seafood. This destination is highly recommended for seafood lovers.

### **Overview:**

On the way to Quy Nhon, we will stop to visit Son My village where the My Lai massacre, one of the most horrific crimes in the Vietnam War took place. Learn about a tragic part of Vietnam history, visit indoor and outdoor memorials and see the changes after the war at this land.

#### **Itinerary:**

A full day tour today will bring us to visit My Lai massacre museum. This place like an evidence where 504 innocent people were killed horrifically on 16th March 1968 and 170 of them died in Son My where the Memorial is now housed.

The Memorial show us a lively images of an excellent museum which depicting the killers, the victims and the items recovered on site. Walking through the fields, you occasionally come across a memorial plaque indicating the number of people that died on that spot. It is truly a historical tour for who caring about the Vietnam war.
