

TOURS ESCAPE FROM QUY NHON

Quy Nhon is the coastal city in Binh Dinh province in central Vietnam. For local people, it is a kind of place to spend couples of day watching the ocean and walking promenade. For foreigners, it becomes less popular. But Quy Nhon deserves to be visited more even though it is not considered as a tourist destination. The medium-size city is blessed with a terrific shoreline of sandy beaches, appeal and tidy. And the countryside that surrounds it is also breathtaking.

Quy Nhon was established as the capital city in the late 19^{th} century but its history dates back to the 11^{th} century in the time of Champa Kingdom. In the 15^{th} century, it also served as the ruling center of Le Thanh Tong – one of the greatest emperors of Vietnamese history. During the Vietnam War, it was a site for intense battle and an important US military and naval base.

Today, the city is a developing port. Fishing and agriculture are the main industries here, making it a food spot to sample some fresh seafood. This destination is highly recommended for seafood lovers.
